Explained what the grant entails: Community Development Grant

Two public hearings and to get the public involved with input and projects.

Certain requirements

Application due by Sept. 29, 2025

Only available after storms, Specific grant

Disaster Recovery Grant

Did meet with Mayor Young and tour around the area, gathered information where the grant could offer relief for the area.

Will need more information from the town in detail.

More data, maps, historical data, etc.

Must tie back to storm damage

Bob did provide some information on damage to water meters from the storms.

Minimum amount allowed in damages is \$750,000.00

Jaison Benoit opened up for discussion

Commissioner Brodhead opened up to Commission for discussion

Commissioner Ahern commented on spending the \$750,000.00

Mentioned SWFTMD assessment

Jaison Benoit commented on grants over loans

Projects awarded must be maintained

Need all information included in projects

Commissioner Brodhead commented on upgrading Safe building for EOC

Commissioner Reardon commented on flood zone area

Commissioner Brodhead commented on upgrading radio communications between employees in the field and management at town hall

Discussion followed on EOC

Commissioner Reardon question on drainage, flooding, water meters.

Jaison Benoit commented on three projects so far, Water System, Critical Facility Upgrade, and third, Storm Water Management.

Discussion followed

Commissioner Brodhead commented that we do not have an emergency shelter for citizens.

Jaison Benoit, shelter cannot be in flood zone, need to have an existing building to make into a shelter

Commissioner Brodhead asked if the Elkins boat ramp could be revamped for the fire dept to do water rescues.

Discussion followed


Commissioner Lynaugh commented on getting trailers for people to live in for a few days during storms.

Jaison Benoit answered that SAVINACIOUS will help with getting the state involved, assisting with getting prepared before and after a storm.


Discussion followed with Public
