**DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY  
TOWN OF INGLIS, FLORIDA  
TROPICAL STORM IDALIA**


Whereas, the Mayor of the Town of Inglis, Florida, of the Laws of Inglis and the Town's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, is designated and empowered to declare that a state of emergency exists within the boundaries of the Town and to authorize the exercise the emergency powers as set forth in Fla. Stat. §870.041-§870.047, the Laws of Inglis, and the Town's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan; and

Whereas, Governor DeSantis, on August 26, 2023, issued Executive Order 23-171, (copy attached as Exhibit A), which order declares a state of emergency in the State of Florida, including Levy County; and

Whereas, Tropical Storm Idalia is likely to strengthen into a hurricane and may pose a danger to the community, critical infrastructure and general welfare of the Town of Inglis;

Therefore, I, Steve Schwing, as Mayor of the Town of Inglis, declare a state of emergency for the municipal boundaries of the Town of Inglis, Florida, effective immediately.
