### 1. Vote for the positions

A quorum was present, reviewed the Inglis Recreation Committee Guidelines, conducted Q&A session, and quorum voted new Board Members:

### 2. Old Business:

- Chris McGann provided an update on the **IRC Back to School Supply Drive**. Thanks to the contributions, we collected five large boxes full of supplies that were delivered to Yankeetown School. And thanks to private donors, even more supplies were delivered in response to the school's last-minute requests. Yankeetown School was happy to kick off the school year with loads of supplies, including 30 new Sony headphones.
- **Splash Bash** - The provisions for this event will be supplied using donation funds: Everything noted from the last meeting is confirmed, except there are still pending updates on the Watermelons, and Soda.
- Additions: Wise Guys Deli will be donating Sausage and Peppers sandwiches
- DJ is confirmed, Water Slide, popcorn & snow cone vendor has been confirmed and will have people working their positions at the event.

  - Watermelon\*\* Pending \$ TBD
  - (2) 13x13 pop up tents (replaced damaged) \$158.36
- Total: \$1,208.48**

- **Vendors:** There will be a total of 24 spots along the ballpark walkway spaced 20' FT apart. (20' x20') area
  - **The Vendors and residents must register with Town Hall by 8/22/25 \*There is a \$5.00 fee - First come First Serve**
  - \*NO CARS will be allowed on the park road - it will be closed from 11:30 AM to 6:30 PM so you will have to enter park between hours of 7:00 AM to 11:00 AM to be able to drive your car in and unload \*\*Please use road only and stay OFF the grass**
  - (12) Vendor spots - The hope is that local Inglis vendors will participate
  - (12) Yard Sale spots for the local residents.
  
- **Volunteers:** There is a need for at least six (6) volunteers
  - \*Meghann noted she has a couple of volunteers- we will have final count at next meeting**
  - \*Rachel & Daryl have followed up with the Fire Department & Sheriff Dept and both will be present at the event.**
  - \*Rachel agreed to make up a sign for Daryl's golf cart.**
