Zully Velazquez, owner of Wise Guys asked the Commission who determines where the money comes from the County. The Commission and Deputy Town Clerk, Tammy Ballinger stated they weren't sure. Commissioner Harry Brodhead stated it sounds like Bronson takes care of it.

Commissioner Daryl Lynaugh asked what the debt looked like. Deputy Town Clerk, Tammy Ballinger, stated the town has no debt.
